Public recognition of these awards will be made at the Annual Architecture Awards Event on Saturday, April 28, 2012.

- Bauhs, William B. Memorial Fund** (awarded to a student(s) who will be participating in an organized study abroad program and return to UIUC after his/her travel.)
- Long, Frank B. and Jennie M. Long Traveling Awards** (awarded to a student for study abroad in architecture.)
- E. Benno Philippson Travel Award** (award is supplemental funding provided to assist an architecture student who is planning to participate in one of the school's organized study abroad programs. It is intended to enable the student to make an actual site visit to a key building or monument, while abroad, which he/she would not have otherwise been able to see firsthand. Indicate intended building or monument in personal statement. Recipient will be required to provide a one page description of his/her experience plus copies of sketches, drawings, etc. showing how the architectural expression and form of the building or monument relates to its setting upon return.)
- Pigozzi, Raymond A. Award** (awarded to students who will be enrolling in an international summer program.)

- Allerton American Travelling Scholarship** (awarded to an undergraduate student(s) for travel in his/her junior year (may include summer); must submit a travel proposal with budget)
- Tyler Allhands Scholarship** (awarded to a student(s) who demonstrates an interest in and is planning a career in the homebuilding industry)
- Chester V. Long Scholarship** (awarded to an undergraduate student(s) with an interest in and talent in the interrelationship between architecture and art and the use of art in architectural design; may submit images from portfolio to show interest)
- Louise Woodroffe Award** (awarded to student(s) based on excellence in watercolor or graphic sketching; submission of two best pieces to Director's Office, TBH with copy of application. **NOTE: Must be a U.S. Citizen.**)
- Louise Woodroffe Prize** (UG/GR - awarded to student(s) based on juried competition of freehand drawings, watercolors or architectural renderings submission of two best pieces to Director's Office, TBH with copy of application.)
